REGULATIONS AND HORSE COMPETITION RULES

1. **BOOK STABLES ONLINE FROM 1 SEPTEMBER. BOOKINGS WILL CLOSE ON 29 OCTOBER. NO PHONE BOOKINGS ACCEPTED www.nominate.com.au**
\$15.00 per night or \$40.00 for the duration of the Show (Thursday, Friday and Saturday) for all stabling (includes Open Yards, Covered Yards and Stables). If vacancies available, bookings can be made on the day. **Stable rules will be policed.**
 - Stables are booked on a 24-hour basis - 6:30am to 6:30am. Stables/yards must be vacated by 6:30am on the day of departure if not booked for that day.
 - Bedding is not provided.
 - Stables must be cleaned, and bedding removed by departure time.
 - Bedding and manure must be deposited at designated manure collection points.
 - Portable yards are not allowed. Electric fences are not permitted in camping or livestock areas of the Showground and will be banned on the main parking area from 6am to 8pm Friday & Saturday. If erected outside these hours appropriate signage must be displayed.
2. **BOOK CAMPING ONLINE FROM 1 SEPTEMBER. NO PHONE BOOKINGS ACCEPTED www.nominate.com.au** Limited number of camp sites available @ \$15.00 per night per site or \$40.00 for the duration of the Show (i.e. Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights). A fee of \$20.00 per site per night, payable to the TRAS Secretary, will apply for any stay before Thursday night or after Saturday night. **Camping will be policed.**
3. **REFUNDS will not be available online via Nominate.** Refunds must be applied for in writing to the TRAS Board via the Secretary and will be dealt with at the first Board Meeting after the Show. Where applicable, a Doctors certificate or a Veterinary Certificate must accompany all refund applications.
4. **DOGS** must always be on leads and under strict control . Dogs are not permitted in Centre Ring. All dogs will be the absolute responsibility of the owner.
5. **HELMETS & FOOTWEAR** - Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Showjumping competitors, pick-up riders and sporting event competitors of any age **must** wear a correctly fitted, approved safety helmet when mounted. All riders under the age of 18 years **must** wear a correctly fitted, approved safety helmet when mounted. All competitors and handlers **must** wear covered footwear when in the main arena.
6. **ATTIRE** - Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are entering.
7. If required by law at the time of this event, copies of all applicable travel documentation as may be in force at the time **MUST** be completed and made available to the Secretary before horses will be permitted to enter the Showground. If Travel Documentation is required at the time of the Show, there will be someone on the gate to collect and verify such paperwork.

- 8. AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES COUNCIL OF NSW (ASC)** rules state all Horse Section competitors **must** sign a **Competitor Waiver** form before competing in any horse event, led or ridden. Waiver forms are available on the TRAS website.
- 9. MURWILLUMBAH SHOW BIO-SECURITY 2018** All horse competitors **must** complete a **Horse Health Declaration** for each horse on the grounds and under their control before any horse can compete at the 2019 Murwillumbah Show. Horse Health Declaration forms are available on the TRAS website.
- TRAS recommends all horses are vaccinated for Hendra Virus.
- 10. Horse Health Declarations and Competitor Waivers** (available on the TRAS website) must be handed to the Nomination Office staff, who will confirm your online entries and provide you with a wristband which permits you entry to the ring.
- 11. A Horse Entry Card** must be completed, with the horse and competitor name clearly written on the card, to be presented to the ring steward when you are placed in any event. The card will be returned to you for use throughout the day.
- 12.** TRAS reserves the right to measure horses: Pony 14hh & under, Galloway over 14hh & not exceeding 15hh, Hack over 15hh.
- 13. Breed Registration** - Breed society memberships and registrations must be current. A copy of registration papers must be produced to Ring Steward/Judge upon demand.
- 14. PERPETUAL TROPHIES** will be retained by the Society.
- 15. A condition of entry in any Saturday horse event** is that prize winners will parade their horse in the Grand Parade. For the public the Grand Parade is a highlight of the Show. TRAS invites participation by all Horse Section competitors. **SATURDAY PRIZEMONEY WILL ONLY BE PAID TO COMPETITORS WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRAND PARADE.** If any competitor has more than one (1) prize-winning horse, only one (1) need be paraded.
- 16.** Where there are **less than three entries** in any class it will rest with the judge to decide whether the exhibit(s) are worthy to receive a prize.
- 17.** Ages of all horses are computed from 1 August, except for Standardbreds, whose age is computed from 1 September.
- 18.** Horses must be free from unsoundness in all classes.
- 19.** Grooms, competitors, and others in charge of exhibits must obey the orders of the Stewards or they will be ejected from the grounds.
- 20.** Competitors are responsible for being in Centre Ring in time for their events. If they do not present in time for that event, judging will proceed without them.
- 21.** Horses/competitors must marshal on the trotting track adjacent to the ring in which they are competing and wait to be called to the ring by a steward. In the event of a trotting race, a steward may direct them to another location.
- 22. Approaching Judges** – no exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a Judge on judging day, before, during or after judging, except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.
- 23.** Under no circumstances may Competitors or their connections gather in Centre Ring or make use of the judges and steward's facilities.
- 24. Prohibited Relationship** – no competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has had a personal relationship or has had horse related dealings within the past twelve months.
- 25. Competitors may not ride more than one (1) horse in any One (1) class.** This regulation may be waived in Championships at the discretion of the Ringmaster.
- 26. Centre Ring Events are in the hands of the Ringmaster.** While every effort will be made to follow the program, the Ringmaster reserves the right to alter the events and/or event schedule.

If in the Ringmaster's opinion conditions (e.g. as a result of rain) make it advisable not to conduct all or any of the ring events because of danger to competitors, he shall convene a meeting, comprising the TRAS President, Deputy Ringmaster(s) and himself and a majority decision of this sub-committee shall be final.

Entry fees paid by competitors for events so cancelled shall be refunded and the committee does not indemnify competitors in any way for events so cancelled.

27. Mares shown in **Brood Mare** Classes are not eligible to enter other classes but are eligible for Championships.

28. Stallions may only compete in Stallion Classes, except in jumping and Western Performance Classes.

29. All led **Colts and Stallions**, irrespective of breed or age, must be shown in a halter equipped with a restraining chain or bit.

30. Stallions are not permitted to be ridden or led by a person under 16 years of age.

31. Competitors, their connections and stewards may **protest**. The only grounds for protest are eligibility and conduct of competitors. Protests must be made in writing and lodged with the TRAS Secretary within 15 minutes of completion of judging of the disputed event: protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$50, refundable if the protest is upheld. **Judges decisions will be final and are not subject to protest.**

32. Cruelty - persons who are considered by a Judge, the Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the grounds. No horse will be permitted to compete if in the opinion of the Judge, Ringmaster or Chief Steward it is in poor health or condition.

33. Drug testing may be carried out at this Show. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

34. ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS JUDGES OR OFFICIALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. OFFENDERS

WILL BE ORDERED FROM THE GROUND AND BANNED FROM THIS SHOW FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS.

35. MAIDEN CLASSES are open to horses which have not won any hack class at an Agricultural Show.

36. NOVICE CLASSES are open to exhibits which have not won Champion or an Open Class at an Agricultural Show or First or Second at a Royal Show.

37. Horses may enter **HACK or HUNTER** classes but are not eligible to compete in both.

38. HACKS and HUNTERS are to be presented/shown in accordance with Show Horse Council Rules.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

39. TWEED SHIRE EVENTS entries are limited to exhibits owned & domiciled within the Tweed Shire for at least 3 months prior to entries closing and if required by the Stewards a declaration to that effect must be signed by any competitor.

40. DISTRICT EVENTS entries are limited to exhibits owned and domiciled within Group 1 for at least three months prior to entries closing and if required by the Stewards a declaration to that effect must be signed by any competitor.

41. BOARD OF TICK CONTROL NOTICE

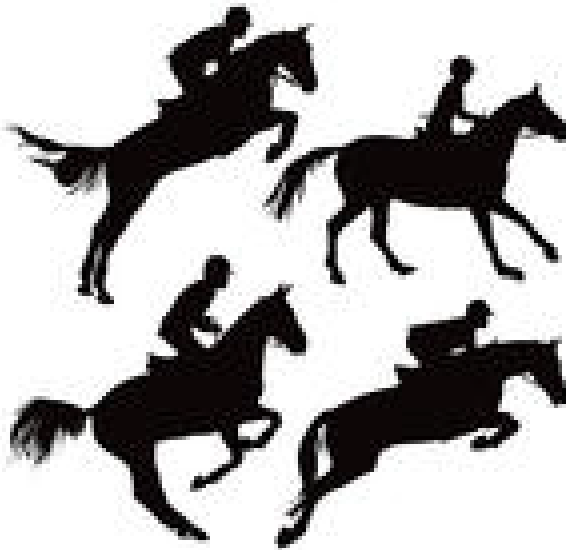
