Judging will be performed by a panel of judges - appointed by the Tweed River Agricultural Society

All Exhibits must be a bona fide work of the Exhibitor, grown or made by the individual.

Exhibits are to be prepared by non- professionals.

All Exhibits must have been completed within the last two years and not previously won a prize at the Murwillumbah Show

All exhibits will remain on display until dismantling on Sunday 3rd November when they will be removed under supervision of the steward.

Completed Entry Forms must be received by the Secretary by 5:00pm Monday 21st October with the exception of Horticulture, which closes 9.00am Friday 1st November.

No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by payment of the appropriate fees.

No exhibit may compete in more than one class.

Male and female exhibitors may compete in all sections and children can compete in open classes.

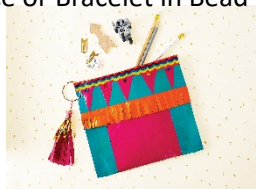
